"The first of Bahá'u'lláh's Teachings is about God and our relationship with Him. God is unknowable in His Essence.

That which has been created cannot understand its creator, just like a table cannot understand the nature of the carpenter that made it. The carpenter's existence is totally incomprehensible to the objects he or she makes.

God created all things and the reason behind our creation is love. Bahá'u'lláh says:

"O Son of Man! I loved thy creation, hence I created thee. Wherefore, do thou love me, that I may name thy name and fill thy soul with the spirit of life."

So although God's existence is far beyond our understanding, His love touches our lives and beings constantly. The way this love flows to us is through His Eternal Covenant. According to this Eternal Covenant God never leaves us alone and without guidance.

Whenever humanity moves away from Him and forgets His Teachings, a Manifestation of God appears and makes His Will and Purpose known to us.

10. Manifestations of God

"Manifest means to reveal or to bring forth something that was not known before."

Manifestations of God are those special Beings Who reveal to humanity the Word and the Will of God; thus when we listen to Them, we are responding to the call of God.

In this world, the sun is the source of all warmth and light, without which life would not exist on the planet. Yet the sun itself does not descend to earth, and if we tried to approach it, we would be totally consumed.

But suppose we take a well-polished mirror and point it to the sun. We will see the image of the sun and the more perfectly polished the mirror, the more perfect the image will be. These Manifestations of God are like perfect Mirrors that reflect the Light of God in all its Splendour and all these Mirrors reflect the same Light.

While God is beyond our reach, these perfect Beings come to us from time to time, live among us, give us guidance, and fill us with the energy we need to progress, materially and spiritually."

13. These Great Oppressions

The aim of the Baha'i Faith, the very purpose of the coming of a new Manifestation of God, is to unify mankind. In the Baha'i Teachings we are told that we are the fruits of one tree and the leaves of one branch. With the coming of Bahá'u'lláh the human race, as a whole, has been summoned to recognize its oneness, and this has launched it on a wholly new stage in its spiritual and social evolution. This is why this Day is so important, as was mentioned in the last quotation. Over 100 years ago a European scholar visited a Prisoner and an Exile whose words have now penetrated the life of every peoples and nation in the world. That Prisoner was Baha'u'llah. He stated during that visit that:

"Thou hast come to see a prisoner and an exile... We desire but the good of the world and the happiness of the nations; yet they deem us a stirrer up of strife and sedition worthy of bondage and banishment... that all nations should become one in faith and all men as brothers; that the bonds of affection and unity between the sons of men should be strengthened; that differences of religion should cease and differences of race be annulled – what harm is there in this?... Yet so it shall be; these fruitless strifes, these ruinous wars shall pass away, and the 'Most Great Peace' shall come... Let not a man glory in this that he loves his country; let him rather glory in this that he loves his kind."

This concludes our musical presentation. We started by looking at the state of the world, and really the state is so poor that even here in Vancouver - one of the nicest places to live in the world - all we have to do is open the newspaper and we see statements such as "We need people to stop killing each other" [or cite another personal or local example]. Bahá'u'lláh teaches that at such times from age to age, times of such moral decay and material deprivation, that our unknowable Creator - God - sends a Perfect Educator [Manifestation, Messenger, etc.] to help civilization advance, enable us to bring unity to the world, and renew the spiritual life of mankind. Bahá'u'lláh is such a Personage, and we thank you for letting us share some of His teachings with you.

However, these are not just nice ideals that are intended to make us feel better about the problems of the world. The Bahá'ís are working in communities all over the world, including this one, to put these teachings into practice and help transform the world. From children to adults, programs for spiritual transformation and the building of unity are being established. For children there are classes for spiritual education where they learn about qualities such as love, justice, respect and kindness. For older children there are programs for spiritual and moral empowerment where they learn to become an agent for positive change in their communities. For youth and adults, study circles which help build capacities for service focus the individual on spiritual development and a systematic study of the Creative Word.

We invite you to learn more about these exciting programs and to further explore the ideas presented tonight.
